- Abraham Lincoln - First Congregational Church Marker**, 54 S Jackson St
- Carrie Jacobs Bond Marker**, corner of parking lot at Milwaukee St & Wisconsin St
- Historical Marker: Black Hawk's Grove & Black Hawk War**, 2100 Palmer Dr (along trail by Blackhawk Golf Course)
- Historical Marker: Burr Robbins Circus**, 920 Beloit Ave (along trail by Dawson Softball Complex)
- Historical Marker: First State Fair**, 51 S Atwood Ave
- Historical Marker: Janesville Tank Company**, 10 S High St
- Historical Marker: Milton House**, 18 S Janesville St, Milton
- Historical Marker: Rock River Industry**, I-39/I-90 Rest Area 17 (only accessible traveling east/south)
- Historical Marker: Route of Abraham Lincoln 1832 and 1859**, 5926 US Hwy 51 (across from Blackhawk Technical College entrance)
- Young America Hall Site Marker**, 19 S Main St
